TRAINING PROGRAM

MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION

This 6 hour, competency-based, class is designed to teach unlicensed personnel how to safely and accurately administer medications to people with disabilities. The class includes 4 hours of training covering the basics of;

- How medications effect the body
- Medication classifications
- Desired effects and potential side effects
- Medication reference options
- Procedures for administration and documentation
- Regulations governing the handling and administration of meds in licensed programs

Following the classroom training, there is an instructor review, the final exam, and a skill demonstration test. Lunch is included.

INSTRUCTOR: A Mount Olivet Rolling Acres nurse skilled in the challenges of administering medications to people with disabilities in home and group home settings.

This class meets all 245B and ICF/MR requirements for medication administration training.
